Dear Attorney General Sessions:

As the Senate considers the nomination of Gina Haspel to serve as Director of the Central Intelligence Agency, it is critical that all Senators have access to information detailing Ms. Haspel's role in the 2005 destruction of videotapes belonging to the CIA. These tapes contained important information relating to the use of so-called enhanced interrogation techniques that are now illegal.

In 2008, the Department of Justice conducted an investigation into the destruction of these tapes that was concluded in 2011. The results of the investigation are found in a classified document known as the Durham Report and it is my understanding that while this report has been made available for members of the Intelligence Committee to review, as well as members of Leadership, it is not presently available for all Senators to review.

I respectfully request that the Durham Report be made available for every Senator to review in the proper setting as soon as possible, prior to casting a vote for or against Ms. Haspel. It is critical that all Senators have access to the same important, relevant information regarding the person nominated to lead the CIA.
