Dear Senator Flake:

Director Ashe has asked me to respond to your and Senator McCain's letter dated December 21, 2014. In your correspondence, you requested an extension of the comment period on the final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Proposed Revision to the Regulations for the Nonessential Experimental Population of the Mexican Wolf (*Canis lupus baileyi*). The final EIS was published November 25, 2014, for a 30-day public review.

Pursuant to the stipulated settlement agreement reached in *Center for Biological Diversity v. Jewell*, Case No. 12-cv-1920 (August 2013), we must submit to the *Federal Register* a final 10(j) determination on or before January 12, 2015. Because of this timeframe, we were unable to grant an extension and have adhered to the 30-day comment period established by Council on Environmental Quality regulation (<https://ceq.doe.gov/nepa/regs/ceq/1506.htm#1506.10>). The comment period closed on Monday, December 29, 2014.
