3 (a) STUDY.—The Comptroller General of the United  
 4 States shall conduct a study on each program or initiative  
 5 authorized under this Act and the following statutes and  
 6 evaluate whether any program or initiative is duplicative:

7 (1) Trafficking Victims Protection Reauthoriza-  
 8 tion Act of 2005 (Public Law 109–164; 119 Stat.  
 9 3558).

10 (2) Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2000  
 11 (22 U.S.C. 7101 et seq.).

12 (3) Victims of Child Abuse Act of 1990 (42  
 13 U.S.C. 13001 et seq.).

1 (4) Runaway and Homeless Youth Act (42  
2 U.S.C. 5701 et seq.).

3 (5) Missing Children's Assistance Act (42  
4 U.S.C. 5771 et seq.).

5 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date  
6 of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General of the  
7 United States shall submit to the Committee on the Judi-  
8 ciary of the Senate and the Committee on the Judiciary  
9 of the House of Representatives a report on the study con-  
10 ducted under subsection (a), which shall include—

11 (1) a description of the cost of any duplicative  
12 program or initiative studied under subsection (a);  
13 and

14 (2) recommendations on how to achieve cost  
15 savings with respect to each duplicative program or  
16 initiative studied under subsection (a).
